**EVERYONE MUST:**

 **Clean their hands, including before entering and when leaving the room.**

**PROVIDERS AND STAFF MUST ALSO:**

 **Put on gloves before room entry. Discard gloves before room exit.**

 **Put on gown before room entry. Discard gown before room exit.**  
**Do not wear the same gown and gloves for the care of more than one person.**

 **Use dedicated or disposable equipment. Clean and disinfect reusable equipment before use on another person.**
