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GENERAL INFORMATION

- PRICE:** Prices quoted shall be net for equipment fully equipped and ready to operate.
- TAXES:** Purchases by the County of Hamilton are not subject to any sales or federal excise taxes. Exemption certificates are not required for municipalities.
- The County of Hamilton is also exempt from the transportation tax and no exemption certificates are required for this tax.
- There is no exemption, however, for Social Security, Unemployment Insurance, and like taxes.
- EXTENSION TO MUNICIPALITIES:** The terms of this contract shall be extended to municipal subdivisions of Hamilton County while it is in effect with Hamilton County. Upon cancellation by either party **in writing**, the contract is likewise no longer valid with the municipal subdivisions.

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DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS

- INTENT:** It is the intention of these specifications to secure guaranteed rental rates on construction equipment with & without operator for a period of one year from date of award. The proposed rates shall be used to tabulate an Equipment Rental with & without Operator list.
- AWARD:** The County of Hamilton reserves the right to rent the equipment at the lowest rate, per bid, from the vendor who can supply the piece of equipment within forty-eight hours at time of need.
- INSURANCE:** At the time of rental, the County of Hamilton will require the value of the equipment, serial number, model number, year and make, and any other pertinent information to secure accurate documentation for inclusion on the County's Liability Insurance and for the procurement of any necessary permits.
- ACCESSORIES:** Literature and specifications shall be submitted for optional accessories on the equipment to be provided.
- CONDITION:** All equipment supplied shall be in excellent mechanical operating condition and shall be no more than two (2) years old unless otherwise noted in detailed specifications. An older machine may be accepted at the discretion of the County Highway Superintendent if it is in the best interest of the County.
- STANDARDS:** Each unit supplied under this contract must comply with all Federal, State, OSHA, DOT, and DEC standards that apply for equipment of its type and class.
- OPERATIONS:** The County will only pay for hours of actual operations. There will be no payment for down time because of mechanical breakdown.
- OFFERS:** Bidders may offer rental rates on the proposal for all equipment they will be able to provide.
